## How You Can Defend State Insurance Regulation



**SUPPORT** legislation to repeal or scale back the Federal Insurance Office

Cosponsor and urge action on the ***Federal Insurance Office Abolishment Act of 2017*** (H.R. 4483), introduced by Rep. Alex Mooney (R-WV).

The proposed legislation would fully repeal the Federal Insurance Office (FIO). The creation of the FIO presented a threat to the system of state insurance regulation, and recently, FIO has attempted to increase its power. This legislation will remove this threat and ensure the states remain the exclusive regulators of insurance.

PIA also supports the bipartisan ***Federal Insurance Office Reform Act of 2017*** (H.R. 3861), introduced by Reps. Sean Duffy (R-WI) and Denny Heck (D-WA).

While PIA National has advocated for and continues to seek the full repeal of this office, we support H.R. 3861 because it will begin to scale back the authority of the FIO, particularly on some domestic matters.



Introduce or support legislation in the Senate to either fully repeal, or scale back, the scope and authority of the Federal Insurance Office.
